

A work relief program established by Franklin D. Roosevelt that lasted from 1933 to 1942.

- Offered millions of jobs to young, unemployed men during the Great Depression
- Developed state and national parks
- Trails and shelters were constructed
- 3 million trees planted








Comfort Station & Contact Station

Comfort Station was constructed in 1934-37 Features rough sawn lumber cladding Contact Station built in the early 1990s

Project Scope includes...

- Replacement of windows & doors
- Demolition of existing bathroom partitions
- Add shower in both bathrooms
- Install an ADA-compliant stall in both bathrooms
- Install dishwashing station in central hallway





Project Scope includes...

- Replacement of windows & doors

- Remove half walls, as they are not historic
- Remove plywood ceiling
